## Location

Race day headquarters and race day registration will be at the Augusta Commons on Broad Street. All races will start in front of the Augusta Commons.

## Packet Pick Up

Participants may register or pick up their race packet at the Sports Expo at the Augusta Marriot on Friday, September 24th from 12:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. or on race day starting at 7:00 a.m. at the Augusta Commons. **Participants are encouraged to pick up their packets the day before the events.**

## 2 Mile Road Race – 7:30 a.m.

Course is a loop of the first mile of the 10K course. The 2 Mile Road Race will start at 7:30 a.m. All entrants receive a t-shirt while supplies last. Awards to top male and female overall finishers. Awards will be given to the top three male and female finishers in the following age groups: 8 and under, 9-12, 13-16, 17-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70 and over. Chip timing will be used.

## 1/2 Mile Fun Run – 8:00 a.m.

Fun run for children ages 9 years and under. The 1/2 Mile Kids Fun Run will start at approximately 8:00 a.m. All children receive a participation ribbon. Awards to overall male and female finishers at the end of the race.

## 10K Road Race – 8:15 a.m.

The 10K Road Race will start at 8:15 a.m. All entrants will receive a tech shirt. Awards to overall male and female winners and to the Masters overall male and female winners (40 - over). The overall race winners and Masters winners are excluded from age group awards. Awards will be given to the top three male and female runners in the following age groups: 14 and under, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70 and over. The course will be closed 1 hour and 40 minutes after gun time (16:06 mile pace). **All participants still on the course will be asked to use the sidewalk to finish the race. Chip timing will be used.**

## Tot Trot – 9:55 a.m.

For children ages 3 years and under. Starts on the Augusta Commons following the 10K. All children receive a participation ribbon.

**Tech shirts and t-shirts are only guaranteed for those preregistered!**

## Course & Timing

The 10K Course is a USATF certified (GA09024WC) and is run completely on asphalt starting at the Augusta Commons area on Broad Street in downtown Augusta. The course is shaded, flat and fast which makes a great PR course and is a Peachtree qualifier. Three water stations will be on the course. In addition, both the 2-mile and 10K will be chip-timed.



## Directions

From I-20, take River Watch Parkway south towards downtown (Exit 200). River Watch Parkway turns into Jones Street. at 15<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right onto 15<sup>th</sup> Street. Take 15<sup>th</sup> to Broad Street. Turn left on Broad Street. The Augusta Commons area is on the left between 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> (James Brown Blvd.) Streets.
